#### **Performance Suggestions**

- Viola is optional.
- Subdivide the quarter-note.
- The cellist should be introduced with great fanfare!!

#### **Pedagogy** Violin Skills Equivalent to Suzuki Vol. 2

- Division of the quarter-note into two eighths
- Maintaining line-identity in a three part round
- Slurred-detache stroke (hooked bowing)
- Baroque rallentando and bow-lift at end.
